# Proposed Concept Drawings for Harbourside Pavilion at Baiter

containing a visitor centre, a café/restaurant, toilets & changing facilities



External seating space would adjoin the restaurant. This visually enlarges the interior area, and itself creates space for enjoying the best of views, mainly towards the west and the south. Moreover, the glazing could be opened during warmer months to expand the perceptible floor area of the restaurant, seamlessly connecting it with the outside.

To enhance the sense of privacy, both the public toilets as well as the changing rooms would be accessible through another 'transitional' space.

The Visitor Centre could incorporate glazing that creates a "feature view" along this wall, out towards the harbour. Upon entering, visitors would see this framed landscape, setting a background tone for this space.
