All other grassed areas will be managed to support our local nature and biodiversity in Boscombe, which means the grass in these areas will not be regularly cut.

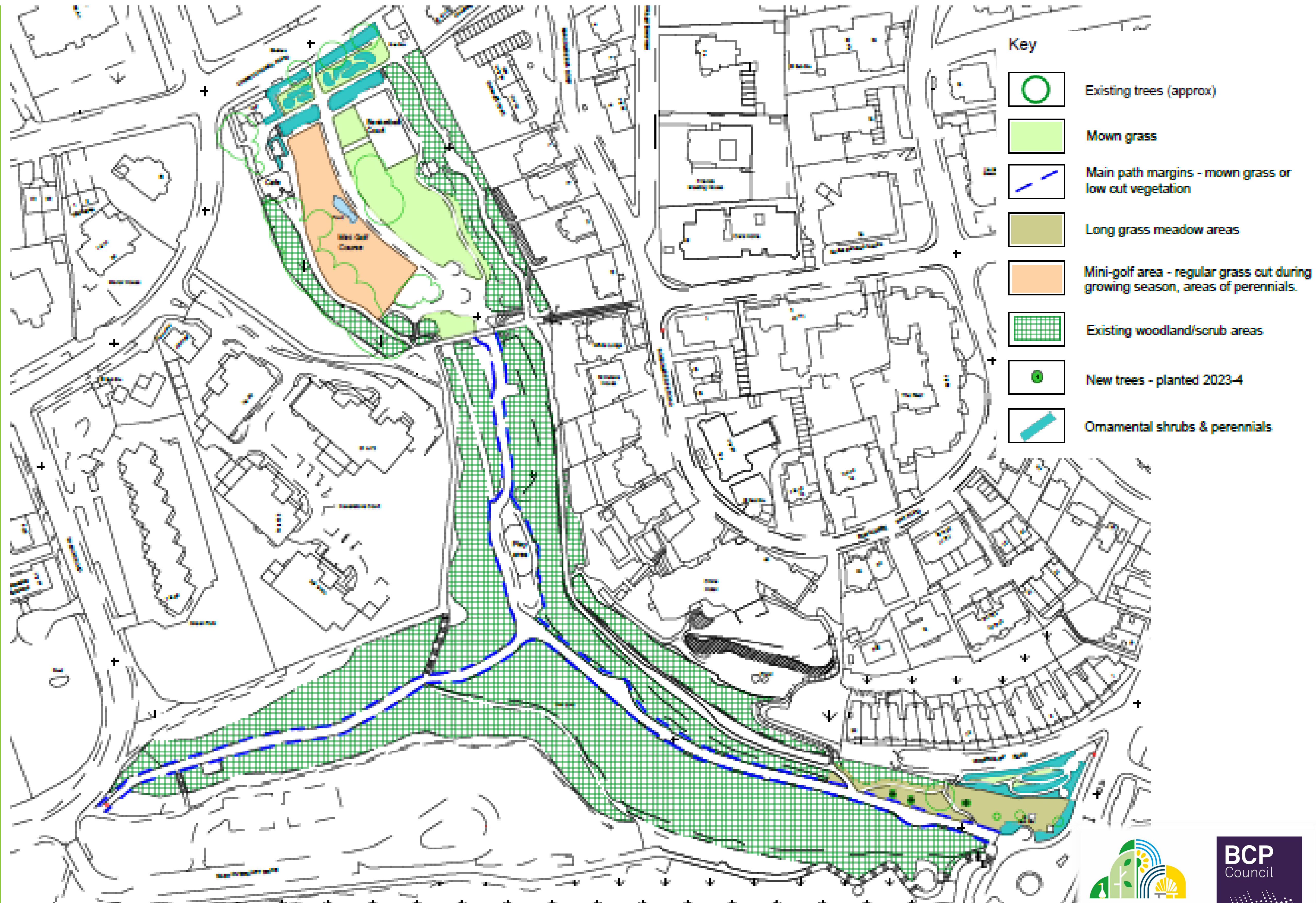
